Late Pick Up

“Parents who pick up their children after the regular closing time of 6:30pm will be charged a late penalty fee of \$5.00 per minute, per child. “

No Call - Bus Fee

Please call before 2 pm if your child will not be on the bus after school. Failure to do so will result in a \$15 service charge billed to your account.

Illness Policy

Your children's health is of great importance. Sick children should not attend school. Please have a backup plan if you cannot leave your job to pick up a sick child. As a general rule, ill children should be picked up within 1 hour of the parent being notified. Children may not return to school until they are fever and symptom free for 24 hours, **without** medication or is seen by a licensed physician who issues written release permitting the child to return to Premier Academy. If your child seems sick, please keep them home to monitor. Please do not give your child fever reducing medication and send them to school, as a fever is a sign of illness and a period of contagiousness.
